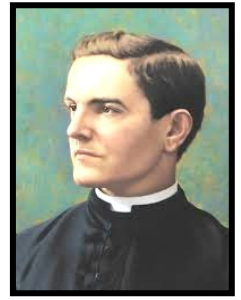

“I am not expecting a lot of people, if the past is any indication, but we will be ready.

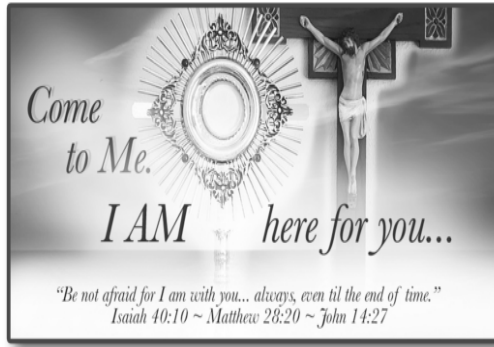
“If we do not get many people, I
