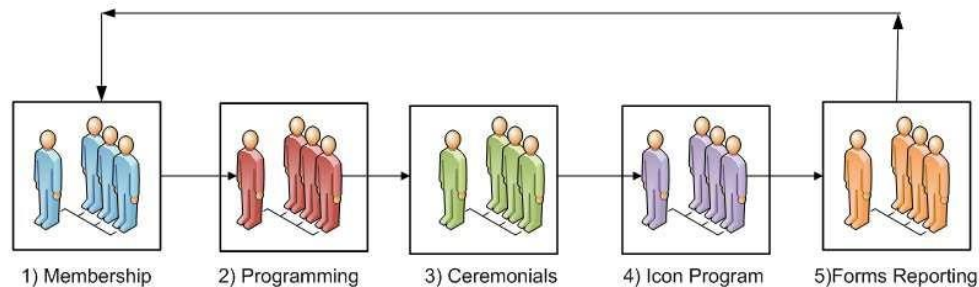


Quarterly Meeting Breakout Sessions

Breakout Sessions (Designed to take 120 mins)

- Speakers should have 60 copies of their handout. We can publish these on the State Website ahead of time if we can get an electronic copy from each breakout session.

2. Programming:

This is For: Councils that run a limited number of Service Projects during the year and need to become more active

How to: In 3-4 mins explain how to plan for more activity in a Council

Handouts: Activity Planner, Council Event Calendar and Event ideas from the State Website, Surge with Service and projects suggested by directors

3. Ceremonials:

How to: In 3-4 minutes explain how a Council can start doing Multi-Degree.

- Getting the team members
- Practices reading the parts
- Practices with the parts memorized
- How to keep the team together by doing regular practices or exemplifications.

Handouts: Easiest way to complete 365 and 185 (i.e. Member Mgmt System). Things to check for on the Audit form. Timeline for all Council forms to be completed each year
