Importance of Using Your Staff

- Not only can you **not** do everything yourself, but trying to will cause you to be **LESS** in control of your council!

- Delegation also **saves you time** so you can **lead** your council to charity vs. manage it

Importance of Planning Meetings

- You are required to hold two regular meetings **each** month (SEC. 124 Charter Constitution Laws KofC)
- Make one of these a Planning Meeting for these benefits:
 - **Reduces unproductive discussion** at the Monthly Business meeting. This reduces the length of the meeting
 - Allows **time to plan** for future Events and Activities
 - Allows **alternative** ideas and strategies to be considered
 - **Makes use of** your Officers & Directors in helping run the council. This saves you, the GK, time! (Delegation)

Roles vs. Duties

- Each Council Officer position has a defined and general role to accomplish
ex. The Chancellor is responsible for getting the membership involved in the activities of the Council.
- Duties are assigned by the Grand Knight to involve, train and give experience to his staff
- Duties will differ from Council to Council and individuals, based on their talents, experience, disposition and the needs of the Council
- So don't waste the abilities of your staff, assign duties to them
