1st Glorious Mystery – The Resurrection

Our Father

On the first day of the week, at early dawn, they went to the tomb, taking the spices which they had prepared.

Hail Mary

And they found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they went in they did not find the body.

Hail Mary

While they were perplexed about this, behold, two men stood by them in dazzling apparel;

Hail Mary

and as they were frightened and bowed their faces to the ground, the men said to them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen.

Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, that the Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and on the third day rise."

After this he appeared in another form to two of them, as they were walking into the country.

And they went back and told the rest, but they did not believe them.

Hail Mary

Afterward he appeared to the Eleven themselves as they sat at table; and he upbraided them for their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they had not believed those who saw him after he had risen.

And he said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to the whole creation.

He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.

And these signs will accompany those who believe: in my name they will cast out demons; they will speak in new tongues;

they will pick up serpents, and if they drink any deadly thing, it will not hurt them;

they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will recover.”

And there appeared to them tongues as of fire, distributed and resting on each one of them.

And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Now there were dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men from every nation under heaven.

And at this sound the multitude came together, and they were bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in his own language.

And they were amazed and wondered, saying, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans?"

And how is it that we hear, each of us in his own native language?

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4th Glorious Mystery – The Assumption

“They shall make an ark of acacia wood;

And you shall overlay it with pure gold, within and without shall you overlay it, and you shall make upon it a molding of gold round about.

Behind the second curtain stood a tent called the Holy of Holies,

and the ark of the covenant covered on all sides with gold, which contained a golden urn holding the manna, and Aaron’s rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant;
